WHAT: The National Consortium of State Guidance Leadership is a coalition of guidance leaders from participating state and territorial education departments dedicated to enhancing career guidance and counseling leadership.

The consortium:

- Provides a vehicle that brings states together to identify and support mutual priorities and ongoing programs
 - Promotes the improvement and further development of career guidance at all levels of education through leadership training
 - Involves organizations that represent business, military, industry, parents and government in developing, improving, and evaluating quality career guidance programs
 - Provides technical assistance to states in developing their annual and long term plans related to career guidance and counseling improvement.
 - Influences career guidance professional literature through research, publishing, and product development

MILITARY MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

The Consortium offers two levels of military membership options.

1. Platinum Level - \$500 membership fee. This might be appropriate for state or regional groups. This level provides:
 - a. Regularly updated mailing list of guidance supervisors across the nation (includes emails)
 - b. Opportunities to present to guidance leaders at the annual national meetings
 - c. Free placement of military programs on web site
 - d. Assist in the dissemination of information/material to consortium network
 - e. National Guidance Leadership team to review of new programs/materials for Military

2. Recruiter/Educational Specialist option membership fee. (\$50.00)
This level provides:
 - a. Regularly updated mailing list of guidance supervisors across the nation (includes emails)
 - b. Opportunities to distribute information to guidance leaders
 - c. Free description of programs and projects on web site and network
 - d. Obtain advise from state guidance leaders
